 Establish a C.P. Information System (a geo-referenced database) to support generation of new products (chart overlays, web-based, Int.) & existing products

- XML
 - XML drives weekly production
 - Content is tagged in XML

What are some of the requirements?

1. International Standards

- Support International Standards (current)
 - S-122 for Marine Protected Areas
 - S-123 for Radio Services
- Support International Standards (future)
 - S-124 for Navigation Warnings
 - S-125 for Nav. Services
 - S-126 for Physical Environment
 - S-127 for Traffic Management

What are some of the requirements (cont.)?

2. Provide weekly updates

- Support current regulatory protocols
 - International and some domestic mariners use NTM's
 - Remaining domestic fleet uses Local NTM's
- Support paper & electronic formats
 - Traditional paper products for POD vendors
 - Continue with current electronic products
 - Have the ability to add emerging products as needed

What are some of the requirements (cont.)?

3. Assess underlying data & its delivery


- Collaborate more with outside groups
 - Deliver intuitive Coast Pilot information
 - Provide info as an add-on option to chart downloads
 - Assess data interoperability to meet customer needs
- Enhance the underlying data
 - Prioritized list of major and minor topics
 - Balance the current and new formats
 - Evolve from "the book" to data centric products
